Workshops are 2 to 3 hours long.



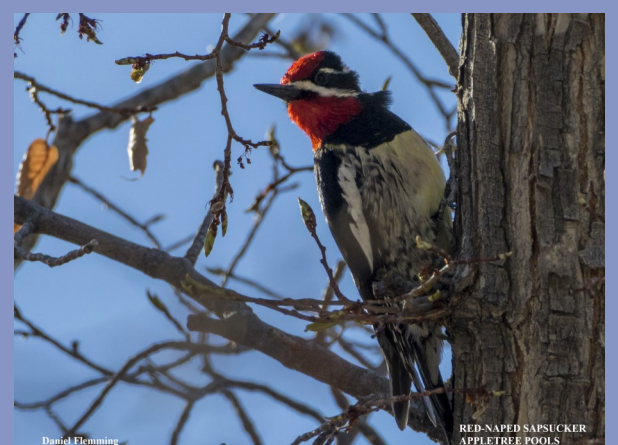
